

Unique Cemetery Site Surrounded by Circular High Embankments

Kiusu Earthwork Burial Circles



ca. 1,200 BCE



Earthwork burial circles were made by digging a circular pit in the ground and piling up the removed earth around the pit in a ring. Pit graves were placed on the inside of each burial circle. The largest one is about 83 meters in diameter and 4.7 meters in height.

A settlement site located on a hill facing Uchiura Bay, demonstrating people's environmental adaptation. The common orient clams excavated indicate a warm climate. Many broken stone tools have been excavated in the archaeological remains of watering place, and ritual activity was held here.

ca. 3,500 BCE to 800 BCE



These shell mounds are on a hill facing Uchiura Bay. Irie is a settlement site in the late of Jomon period, with graves and a shell mound, and excavations have also uncovered the buried bones of a person affected by muscular atrophy. Takasago is a cemetery site from the final of Jomon period.
